



Declaration of Intention

**Subject: Not Accepting Gifts and all Kinds of Presents in return for
Duty Performance (No Gift Policy) of the Office of the Attorney
General for the Fiscal Year B.E. 2567 (2024)**

The Cabinet Resolution on 8 December B.E. 2563 (2020) approved the National Reform Plan on the Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (revised version) by specifying important reform activities. Activity 4 aims to develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and without undue benefit. Goal 1, Section 1.1, requires all government agencies to declare that they are agencies where all government officials shall not accept gifts and all kinds of presents when they perform their duties (No Gift Policy).

The Office of the Attorney General, which is considered the crucial government agency in the justice system gives precedence to the No Gift Policy which aims to result in fairness in society and has a positive effect on the people and the country as a whole. We commit that all personnel of the Office of the Attorney General shall perform their duties with transparency and conscientiousness, adhere to honesty and integrity, and oppose all forms of corruption and misconduct.

Therefore, in order to express a strong intention to oppose all forms of corruption and strengthen morality, ethics, honesty, integrity and transparency in performing our duties, we declare that **“The Office of the Attorney General is an agency where all the executives and the government officials in the agency shall not accept gifts and all kinds of presents either during/before/or after performing duties (No Gift Policy)”** to prevent unfair performance of duties and avoid any conflict of interest, including building good governance and accountability culture and attitude. The executives and supervisors at all levels must perform their duties decently, as well as supervise their personnel to carry out their work rightly and strictly, and publicize this declaration of intention to the public.
